2017 Enrolment Fees - Overseas Students

Application Fee	Overseas \$500	Application to Enrol forms are submitted prior to payment of the Application Fees. Application Fees become due, together with the Acceptance Fee, once the School has issued a Conditional Offer of Enrolment, and the Conditional Offer is Accepted. The Application Fee (which is non-refundable and inclusive of GST) is payable by credit card, cheque or cash, directly to the School.
Acceptance Fee	Overseas \$2000	Payable when accepting the Conditional Offer of Enrolment. The Acceptance Fee (which is non-refundable) is payable by credit card, cheque or cash, directly to the School. The School's receipt of the payment of the Acceptance Fee, together with the Parent signatures on the Application to Enrol form, constitutes acceptance of the conditional place offered.

Notes

1. The Schedule of Fees & Charges is set each year by the School Council and may vary from time to time by written advice.
2. Additional Charges will appear when optional activities such as Basketball, Band and VETB Courses etc are participated in.
3. This Schedule of Fees & Charges only applies to Overseas Students. A separate Schedule exists for Local Students.

Payment of Fees & Charges

The Parents are to pay all Overseas Student Fees & Charges annually, in advance, by the end of the first week of Term 1.

It is preferable that Overseas Student Fees & Charges are paid:

1. Online - Log into the Parent Portal (<https://edumate.stlukes.nsw.edu.au>) and access Payment Options by Direct Debit or Credit Card. (Visa, Mastercard or American Express - A 1% surcharge applies to Credit Card transactions.)
2. BPAY® (including Debit or Credit Card linked to bank account)

If an account for Fees and Charges is not paid in full within 60 days from its due date, the Student's enrolment may be suspended and the Principal may without further notice refuse entry to the Student and/or terminate the Student's enrolment.

Withdrawal of Student

Parents are to give at least one full term's notice in writing to the Principal, Mrs Jann Robinson (principal@stlukes.nsw.edu.au) before terminating the Student's enrolment. If the Parents do not give sufficient notice of termination of the Student's enrolment, they are to pay to the School one term's School Fees, plus GST as applicable.

Family Allowance

A concession in School Fees is allowable where two or more members of the immediate family concurrently attend the School (Dee Why or Bayview Campuses) and where no other concession applies, eg, a scholarship. The concession is not open to students placed by corporate debtors. The Family Allowance is for School Fees and does not extend to Service Charges.
